Slide breaks down immediately in the stomach and does not affect absorption rate of medication.

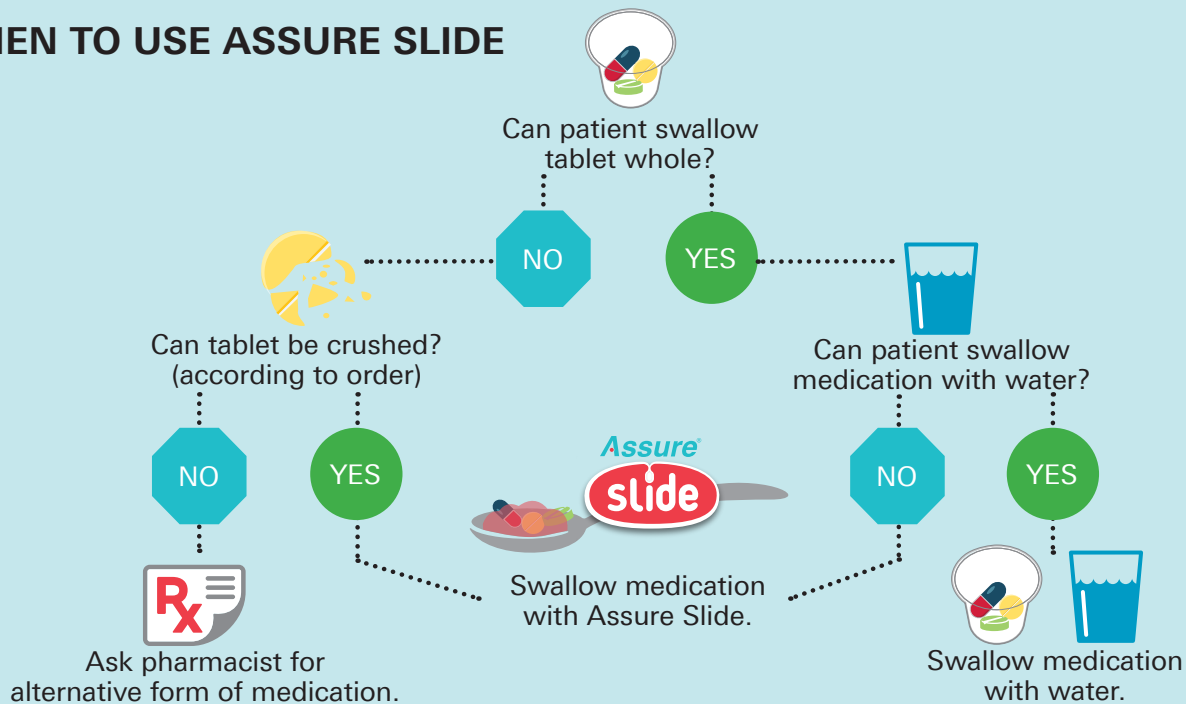
+ Offered in two thicknesses.
